# Infrastructure

The school has a pride of owning 3.5 acres of land.

The academic building consists of Class rooms, Library, Laboratories, Art & Craft, Music room and A.V. room with digital board. The school campus covering a vast area comprising:

Administrative Block - includes conference hall and different offices

Academic Block - includes spacious classrooms, which provide the right ambience and feel for studies.

Separate hall - for Art & craft, music, computer, library and laboratories. Boys & Girls Hostel - comprising independent hostels for boys and girls with common dining hall & kitchen.

Accommodation - for Hostel Superintendent.  
Separate accommodation - for Principal.



## Play Group Section

The toddlers, who just step out of mother's laps, step into our school. The school is not a school but it is a play way learning institution. Toddlers are not at all stressed with the education. For them it is playing and learning. They are left free to the nature and are taught through teaching aids, singing songs, playing games and telling stories.

They also enjoy themselves in the park, which help them in developing physically and mentally.

Besides, they have classes in art & craft and computer in which they learn various activities and enjoy games, cartoons, rhymes and word art on computers.

They are taught good manners and English conversation.

The promotion in the kindergarten depends on On-Going- Evaluation.

## Primary Wings

Seeing is learning" This is where real teaching begins. Knowledge on various topics in all subjects is given mostly through teaching aids and through the environment. The study is not a burden for children.

They are not overloaded with homework. Most of the subject matter is covered in school itself and light homework is assigned. Every child is encouraged to participate in extra curricular and co-curricular activities. The impetus is given to moral values, loyalty, hard-work and discipline to make him/her a better individual. Monthly tests are conducted to make evaluation an on going process to keep the child free from the stress of term exams.

## Wings of DBS

The academic Block consists of basically four wings

Kindergarten: Play Group - Nursery - LKG-UKG.

Primary wing: Classes I to V

Junior wing: Classes VI to VIII

Senior wing: Classes IX to XII

# House System

One of the main objectives of having House system in our school is to foster a sense of collective responsibility and solidarity. Inter house competitions conducted in various fields rekindle and develop the social qualities and inherent talent in every student. It is the house system that channelise discipline in the school and encourages the child to participate in extra curricular activities.

The school students are divided into four houses namely. Tagore House Symbolizes Noble laureate Rabindranath Tagore, who was inclined towards nature so the house colour is green.

Tilak House: Named after Balgangadhar Tilak has red colour.

Raman House Named after Dr. C.V. Raman has blue colour.

Vivekananda House: Symbolizes Swami Vivekananda has yellow colour

# Conduct and Discipline

The school lays emphasis on self-discipline for without discipline it is not possible to achieve excellence in any field. Harsh humiliating and corporal punishment is not permitted. It is our aim to imbibe in each student a sense of good manners and behavior and to foster a sense of co-operation and respect for elders. However keeping the interests of the students in mind, it is necessary to take appropriate step incase of inappropriate behaviour. In extreme or repeated cases of indiscipline. the school may expel a student. In such cases the decision of the principal will be final.

# Junior Wing

With the intention to prepare a student to face Board Exams, the school prepares the student with thorough knowledge of topics and train them in various fields so that their talents can be given protection and they can become skillful and lead the society one day. They are made creative by doing one project per subject annually. The school provides enough study material other than books. The students have monthly tests in order to reduce the tension of exams.

# Senior Wing

The students in this wing are prepared to be better citizens and develop their skills. They are counseled to choose the different streams like, engineering, medical, management for their future.

# Tutorial Group

Teachers are also part of each house and they are the TUTORS of the house. Each house has able house master / house mistress for monitoring house activities and competitions. They look after all round development of each individual. As the potter is to a pot so is the tutor to a student. The tutor of the child looks into the behaviour, moral values, education, studies, games, discipline, curricular activities etc. of the child.

# Conference Hall/AV Room/Multi Purpose Hall

The students of the 21 st century should get the global education with the help of Internet LCD projector and audiovisual aids. The multipurpose hall is equipped with projector and audio visual aids. From time to time slides related to different topics are shown. Education oriented workshops and seminars are held from time to time. It is also used for general meeting and certain competitions.

## Art & Craft

The first line the child draws or dabbles in colours is the child's peculiar self expression in order to bring out the hidden talent in every child. The art & craft classes are provided right from Playgroup.

Annual Exhibition is held to encourage the talent of the DBSites. Creating attractive things out of waste is the main subject which develops a sense of creativity among the children.

Various competitions like Sit and draw, Doll making, Card- making, Rakhi making, are held throughout the year.



## Music

We have musical instruments like Synthesizers, Drums and Guitars. Music is an integral part of the curriculum and co curricular programmes. Learners are skilled in vocal and instrumental music. Music classes help to develop the child's aesthetic, creativity, spirituality and cultural potentiality. Music is the soul of our cultural heritage. Children are trained to participate in different functions like their Parent's Day and Inter school solo song competition and many more of such events.

## Library

The school is proud to have a library with a rich collection of Books, Periodicals, Journals and CDs on various subjects. -

Besides we have state-of-the-art surfing facilities of getting access to national and world libraries through Internet.

The students from Nursery onwards utilize the library. Kindergarten classes are narrated stories by the teachers; Classes I to IV use the Library books and periodicals within Library Hall and from classes V onwards books are issued.



# Educational Tours! Quarterly Hostel Outings

The school keeps on arranging study tours and excursions from time to time in order to encourage informal education and to expose the children to learn by seeing and exploring things for themselves and adding to the store of knowledge.

## Tuck Shop

The school also has the facility of Tuck Shop, which provides fresh stuff with a variety of food accompanied by snacks, cold drinks, pastries, soups etc. The tuck shop is open to each and every individual of school.

The school office issues coupons to the students against the desired amount, which will be valid to buy eatables from the tuck shop located within the school campus. The students are not allowed to use money in Tuck Shop.

## Sports

It is believed that physical fitness and good can and should flow from sport- ing activities, which are more important. Students are benefitted enormously from training and playing together in pursuit of a common goal and from participating in a field of endeavour, where team work rather than Individual is rewarded. Our school is proud to have a wellequipped games section with a big playground where most of the sports take place.

Our coach trains the children to play Basketball, Volleyball, Badminton, Foot ball, Cricket, Track and field, Table tennis, etc.

Co-curricular and Extra-curricular Activities Co-curricular and Extra-curricular interests that give an edge over the others. Keeping in view the need to develop the individual holistically students are encouraged to exploit the latent talents in areas of music, dance, drama, intellectuals pursuits, writing and paintings. These activities form an integral part of the curriculum fostering a healthy culture amongst the students. This associations provides the platform to express their talent.

Teachers' activities like seminars, exposi- tion, presentation, field trips, meets and other related events form a regular feature in the teaching life.

Besides inter house Competitions we invite Inter school competitions too.



# Computer Education

Our school computer Lab is well equipped with enough computers. The computer classes begin from kindergarten where children enjoy cartoons, games, and word art. From class onwards the computer lessons are carried out. The middle classes are taught surfing, Higher classes have class in C, C++, JAVA and HTML Python. AI etc.

Besides, the children use internet in order to explore more knowledge in various subjects. They are provided by different CDs, of different subjects.



## Transport

The school is having a fleet of buses, which provides pick and drop facility from every corner of the city.

## Laboratory

The school building also includes the five science laboratories namely: Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Composite and Mathematics. Each Lab is big enough to accommodate enough students.

# Residential Facility

Hostel of DBS is a "Home away from Home". The school has a separate building for boys' and girls' hostel. The rooms are spacious. Every child is allotted an independent locker and a cupboard. Separate Hygienic dining hall is spacious to have their meals together.

The students are provided with vegetarian and non-vegetarian food as well. There is no compromise regarding the diet of the children. Fresh and seasonal food is offered at every meal. There is a team of tutors who look into the study matters of the children and take extra efforts to bring the children up to the mark. Students utilise their extended noon hours in developing extra curricular activities like games and art & craft, singing & dancing etc. Outings are fixed up periodically for boys and girls separately. Every requirement of children regarding curriculum is attended immediately.

Hostel has its own mini library with daily newspapers and periodicals'.

Boarders enjoy three breaks in a year i.e.

- > Summer break- 30 days approximately
- > Puja holidays - 15 days approximately
- > Winter holidays-20 days approximately



# Health and Hygiene

Tie-up with well-established hospitals is to provide the right health care to the students hygiene. To ensure total concentration in their endeavor the respective hostels are designed to be a home away from home. All arrangements are made for a comfortable, yet affordable stay. The respective wardens play key roles in providing the appropriate psychological comfort for the students.

DBS takes special care in providing quality food for the boarders maintaining the vital standards for proteins, vitamins and necessary minerals for effective growth. We do this under the able and learned guidance of nutritionists. A healthy body carries a healthy mind. Until & unless the child is healthy enough he will not be able to put his full efforts to any work it may be studies, sports or any other activity.

In order to ensure good health, the school has a provision of health team comprising of a doctor, who visits school periodically, a trained nurse who remains with the children round the clock.

## Parents Teachers Meeting (PTM)

The enhancement of child for all round development is not possible only by the effort of the school. Parents do play an important role simultaneously. Keeping in view the above school has arranged parents teachers meeting from time to time. The aim of PTM is to discuss the shortcomings of children and accordingly steps are taken. Parent's advice for the development of school is always welcome.
